## REVISED --NOTICE TO ALL CHERRYBROOK HOMEOWNERS REGARDING TURNPIKE CONSTRUCTION AND BLASTING

We have had contact with David Harrison {855-253-7522} from Terra Mechanics, and want to pass on the following information provided us:

- Homes that fall within 1,500 feet are the only ones that will be offered a baseline survey; that is, basically any home on the right side of Cherryhill Drive, but not all homes.
- Blasting will not start until February, 2019. The deadline for obtaining the baseline survey will go beyond the original cutoff of December 17. There are 50 to 60 owners who have been notified by Terra Mechanics.
- It is Terra Mechanics responsibility to offer the baseline survey to any owner within the 1,500 feet from the blasting point.
